We will stitch out an assortment of quilt blocks including:

- Basic free motion,
- Fussy cut free motion
- Standard embroidery
- Basic folded fabric
- Traditional folded fabric
- Standard applique
- Confetti applique
- Raw edge applique
- Blanket stitch applique
- Landscape
- Crazy Quilt
- Sashing
- Plus, much much more...

We will do 1, 2, or 3 blocks as time allows. The easier blocks are quicker to stitch up, the more complex blocks are more time consuming.

You may choose from a 6-, 7- or 8-inch quilt block. Note that all blocks should be the same size throughout the series. There is a sample of the different 6-, 7- or 8-inch sizes available in the store.

We will discuss how many blocks to make quilt sizes desired.

We will have quilt assembly and finishing classes.

An embroidery machine is required to do this class with a 6-, 7- or 8-inch hoop
