## **Project: IQ Designer Shoulder Bag**

This is a 2 part class with 2 separate supply lists.

### **Supply List: Class One**

- **Machine with embroidery capabilities And IQ designer or my IQ design center.**

#### **Embroidery arm of machine and largest Hoop for your machine.**

- Thumb Drive if borrowing machine
- Role of no-show mesh stabilizer. Do not cut
- Fabric for purse; pockets, front, back, flap and pockets approx. 1 ½ yds, Do not cut this outside fabric. You may not need the total 1 ½ yards, but extra is essential due to differences in hooping. Straps 4 ½" x width of fabric x 4 pieces. In addition to the 1/1/2 yards above. Ok to cut straps.
- Low loft batting: one yard, do not cut.
- Low loft batting 1" x 40" x 4 pieces for straps.

Contrasting embroidery thread for fill design on bag. Pre-wound bobbins

- **Basic Embroidery supplies including scissors, pins and anything you normally use when embroidering.**

#### **\*Basic embroidery Supplies**

- Embroidery Machine, Power Cord
- Embroidery Unit & largest hoop available for your machine
  - pre-wound bobbins
  - Needles topstitch 90/14

### **Before Class:**

**Press fabric prior to class. Cut nothing except straps. Class one will be all IQ designer and embroidery with no regular sewing.**

Class will start and end promptly—please be set up and ready to begin class on time.
