Before Class:

Cut all fabric pieces

*When cutting MAIN fabric the design will be horizontal when finished, so if you choose a directional fabric cut accordingly.

**We will be making a folded fabric "tie" from the strip of fabric, either fold into fours and top stitch or stitch and turn a tube.

***If you are making a Marker roll up or if you'd like to use for Makeup brushes; it is recommended that the fabric be finished with an iron-on vinyl first before making the roll-up. You will need 3 pieces of Slicker Glossy Iron on Vinyl 12x17in (vinyl is 17in on bolt). If using, iron on to the 3 fabric pieces before class. By adding the vinyl, the roll-up will wipe clean of any marks or spills.

Class will start and end promptly—please be set up and ready to begin class on time.

Your payment is your commitment to your class and to the instructor. The class may be postponed or refund issued IF a minimum enrollment is not met. You must give a 3-day notice to transfer the fee to another class. Students must have basic knowledge of their own sewing machine, including how to operate and thread your own machine. **Please note:** Neither your instructor or Pins & Needles can be responsible for forgotten supplies and/or equipment. Please be sure to have all of your supplies properly labeled.
