Project: Nervous Serger Zipper Bag supply list

Serger with 4thread overlock

Foot pedal, power cord and supplies

instruction manual and threading guide

Serger cording foot and basic serger foot

Fabric A: **back**, one piece 12" by 9"

Insert for the bottom front one piece 4 ½" x 5"

top front 12" long by 4 ½" wide

Fabric B: **Ruffle**: 3" 30"

Cord: 14" of ¼" or similar size cord or piping. Can use braided cotton cord or piping

Fabric C: 1 ½" by 14" to cover **cording**

Fabric D: 2 pieces 9" x 12" **lining**, 2 pieces 4 ½" x 5" for **bottom front**

2 pieces lightweight fusible interfacing each 9" x 12"

Zipper to match. **Needs to be at least 16 inches and polyester or nylon, not metal**

Two spools embroidery thread for decorative finish on seams

4 cones serger thread for construction

Before Class:

Cut fabrics, label and press. Bring extra of fabric in case of error.

Class will start and end promptly—please be set up and ready to begin class on time.

***Basic Sewing Supplies**

- ☐ serger, Power Cord, & Foot Pedal
- ☐ 2 spools embroidery thread for wave stitch if no wave stitch will use in upper and lower looper
- ☐ 4 cones serger thread
- ☐ Needles serger 80/12
