Serger Sampler Supply Sheet

Supply List:

Any Presser Feet you have for your Serger
Sergering Notions- See Basic Sergering Supplies Box.
Wonder Clips/Pins.
Frixion Pen or chalk marker.
80/12 serger needles
Rotary Cutter/Cutting Mat

Thread:

4 cones of serger thread (neutral colors)
12 wt thread- 4-8 different colors that accent
your fabric choices. 30wt can also be used.
1 or 2 spools of wooly nylon or stretch thread

Fabric:

Block Fabrics- You will need 8 – ½ yard cuts of coordinating fabrics.

Sashing: 1 ¼ yards

Backing: a piece large enough to be 3 inches bigger on all 3 sides of quilt. Can be pieced together with scraps left from quilt top.

Binding: ¾ yard

Batting: 55 x 55 piece

Presser Feet:

Standard Foot, Pintuck foot, Curved foot, Cover/Chain foot, Lace Applicator foot, Cording Foot P5
We will have these feet available to use during class. Other optional techniques will be used if you do not have a cover stitch machine.

*Basic Sergering Supplies

- Serger/Foot Petal & Power Cord
- Fabric Scissors
 - Seam Ripper
- Fabric Marker/chalk
 - Serger Needles
- Tweezers, Screwdriver & allen wrench If needed to change needles
- Instruction manual for serger
- Reference Guide for threading

Class will start and end promptly—please be set up and ready to begin class on time.

- Stabilizers & Hoops: (embroidery classes)
- Small ruler
- Embroidery scissors
- Straight pins
- Fabric marker
- Pencil or pen & note paper
- Glue stick
