### Before Class:

#### \*Basic Sewing Supplies

- Sewing Machine, Power Cord, & Foot Pedal
  - Embroidery Unit & indicated Hoop(s)
    - Pre-Wound Bobbins
    - Sewing Bobbins
    - Scissors
  - Pins / Wonder Clips
- Sewing / Embroidery Needles

They will need to quilt the main fabric, soft & stable and the lining together by quilting before cutting the pattern out. For quilting they can take it to a quilter or do it themselves. To make it easier to quilt the material they can cut it into 2 separate pieces then quilt them together. (The patterns have very good instructions on how to do this) I have a suggestion if they need to quilt is with a straight stitch. Quilt it on an angle, if the quilting isn't perfectly straight, it doesn't show as much. They could also diamond quilt the material.

In the pattern comes labels to identify each piece. Make a copy of this and cut out each label. (I color code them according to where I will use them by highlighting each section)

To cut it out after quilting it, measure and draw all pieces on the quilted material before cutting them out. The patterns have good pictures of for placement.

After cutting each piece out, pin the labels at the top on each piece. (some pieces are so close in size that this makes it easier to grab the piece you need.

Lastly, stitch around each piece about 1/8th of an inch. This makes it much easier to sew the pieces together by pushing the soft and stable down.

Class will start and end promptly—please be set up and ready to begin class on time.

- Threads
- Fabric
- Stabilizers & Hoops: (embroidery classes)
- Small ruler
- Embroidery scissors
- Straight pins
- Fabric marker
- Pencil or pen & note paper
- Glue stick
