### Basic Embroidery Supplies

- ◆ Embroidery machine, power cord, embroidery arm
- ◆ USB stick
- ◆ Various size hoops
- ◆ Embroidery foot
- ◆ Thread and bobbins
- ◆ Embroidery needles 80 or 90
- ◆ Fabric marking pens/markers/chalk
- ◆ Fabric and thread scissors
- ◆ Straight pins, seam ripper

### Additional Supplies for this Project

- Ameila Scotts Edge to Edge Book with CD
- A panel or quilt sandwiched together (top, batting, backing, secured together)
- Design of choice loaded on USB stick both A and B with choice of 3 sizes
- Nancy Zieman double sided basting tape
- Medium wt tearway stabilizer
- Grid ruler or measuring tape to measure center of quilt
- Floriani perfect stick tape
- Calculator (optional)

\*\*\* Quilting a panel is easier to quilt to start with but nothing smaller\*\*\*

**It is important to leave approx 6 inches of backing around entire edge of quilt for hooping.**
