### Project: Zippered Wristlet

### Supply List:

**SEWING MACHINE in good working order with instruction manual, power cord and foot pedal, zipper foot**

#### \*Basic Sewing Supplies

- Sewing Machine, Power Cord, & Foot Pedal
- Sewing Bobbins
- Pins
- Needles topstitch 80/12 or 90/14

#### \* Basic Sewing Supplies and bobbins

- EDGE JOINING FOOT-not essential, but Extremely useful- best foot ever!
- Polyester zipper 10" or larger>NOT METAL
- Small swivel hook and D-ring ½" -may not be available at Pins and Needles.
- 12mm decorative snap- instructor will bring snap tool and extra snaps.
- Fabric 1 cotton-outer fabric- Two pieces 6 ¼" x 4 ½" for outer pieces
- Fabric 2 cotton One 4 ½" x 4 ½" pocket piece-This can be cork, vinyl covered candy wrapper, or any decorative technique that is not too heavy and can be sewn. Be aware that a snap must go through it and a small portion will be covered by a tab.
- Fabric 3 cotton (lining, pocket tab and wrist tab) Two 6 ¼" x 4 ½" lining pieces. One 5 ¼"x 4 ½" pocket lining-this will show at top of pocket. One 6"x2" pocket tab. One 12" x 2" wrist strap. One 4"x 2" piece for D ring placement.
- Medium weight fusible interfacing. Two 6 ¼"x 4 ½" for outer pieces. One 4 ½"x 4 ½" for pocket. One 5" x 1" Strip for pocket tab. One 11"x 2" for wrist strap
- Matching thread
- Extra of all fabric just in case.

### Before Class:

**Cut and press all fabrics. If using cork or marine vinyl, do not press. Label pieces**

Class will start and end promptly—please be set up and ready to begin class on time.
