

Pins & Needles

Project: Foam Bag for Hoops, scanning board or laptops.

Supply List:

Sewing machine in good working order.

This project can be done with or without IQ designer.

- 1 yd of outside main cotton fabric- this will be a little more than needed
- 1 yd of cotton fabric for lining, gusset, Inside pocket and decorative strips
- One sided fusible interfacing - two pieces 3 ½"x 38", and one piece 14" x18". (shape flex- pellon sf101)
- Piece of foam (pellon flex foam, bosal in R foam, ByAnnie soft and stable or similar foam) 19" x 42". available at Pins and Needles. Can be fusible or non-fusible. Can be pieced by butting edges together and zigzagging.
- Marking instruments (Chalk or frixon pen)
- Decorative thread for quilting outside of bag and thread for embroidery on buttons
- Sewing thread for sewing bag together
- 2 half ball cover buttons ½"
- Buttonhole foot if not using buttonholes in embroidery machine
- 44 to 36" of 1" wide webbing for handle
- **Sewing feet:** Regular foot (J Babylock), foot for character stitches (N babylock), walking foot, edge joining foot
- Regular sewing and machine embroidery supplies
- Top stitch needles 80/12 or 90/14

*Basic Sewing Supplies

- ☐ Embroidery Machine, Power Cord, & Foot Pedal
- ☐ Embroidery Unit & largest hoop
- ☐ Sewing Bobbins & pre-wound bobbins
- ☐ Pins
- ☐ Needles topstitch 80/12 or 90/14

If using embroidery machine, have embroidery section of machine, decorative thread for quilting, pre wound bobbins. USB stick if borrowing machine, 5x7 hoop (preferable magnetic) for placing button hole, and largest hoop available for quilting foam to fabric.

Strongly suggest Magnetic hoops. Better with foam and easier

If **not using IQ designer** bring decorative thread, pre wound bobbins, walking foot (with quilting bar if available) and marking pen, ruler for marking fabric

Before Class:

Have your fabric pressed and ready, but do not cut fabric. First class is to prepare fabric, 2nd to assemble bag.

Class will start and end promptly—please be set up and ready to begin class on time.
