Working order

- 12 inch pillow form
- Wing (or hemstitch) needle 100/16
- Universal needles 80/12
- Flat <u>non-gathered</u> lace at least 13" long And about 4 to 6" wide. If lace is Narrow bring a yard and we will piece Together to make a wider piece
- ½ yard main fabric, this will be a panel In the front as well as back of pillow
- Two strips of coordinating fabrics 14" long By approx. 4 to 6" wide
- Regular sewing foot and foot for character stitches
- Sewing thread to match lace
- Sewing thread to do hemstitching
- Sewing thread for construction of pillow
- Sewing supplies (pins, scissors, seam ripper etc.)

Before Class:

Have your fabric pressed and ready.

Class will start and end promptly-please be set up and ready to begin class on time.

Your payment is your commitment to your class and to the instructor. The class may be postponed or refund issued IF a minimum enrollment is not met. You must give a 3-day notice to transfer the fee to another class.
